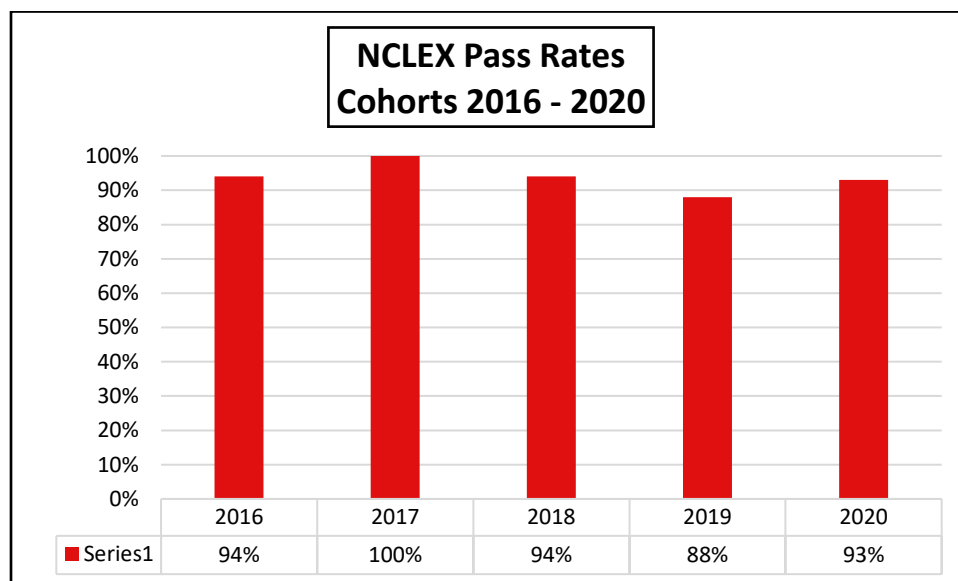

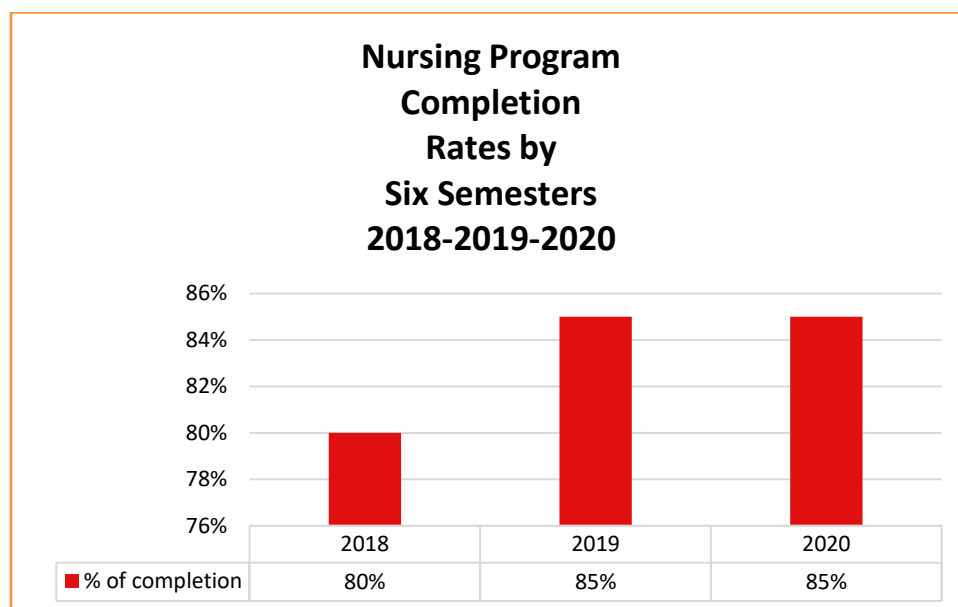

The 2020 graduating cohort for the Nurse Education program had 93% NCLEX pass rate, and 16 out of 17 students graduated within 6 semesters of starting the first Clinical Nurse Education course. This translates to an 85% completion rate.
