## Step 2

### MEET WITH AN ACADEMIC ADVISOR

Meet with an Academic Advisor to determine your next steps. To determine placement into English and math courses, various measures will be used. SAT scores, college transcripts showing college level English and math courses, and/or high school GPA may exempt you from the placement test. Bring along a copy of your high school or college transcript or SAT scores when meeting with an advisor.

If placement test is not required, your next step is to register for classes. The Academic Advisor will assist you in selecting the appropriate courses to help you achieve your educational and career goals. No appointment is needed. Stop by the Office of Student Services:
