

Student Usernames & Passwords

Campus Computers, Email, Library Databases, and Office 365

Every student has an assigned WCCC email which is used to log into the computers on campus, WCCC email, the library databases, and Microsoft 365.

WCCC Email: first initial last name and the number 1@warren.edu

Example: Philip Howard's username would be phoward1@warren.edu

Password: Your default password is the first two letters of your first name (first letter uppercase, second letter lowercase) followed by your birth month (2 digits), your birthday (also 2 digits), the last 4 digits of your Social Security number, and an exclamation point.

Example: For Philip Howard, born on January 1st, with the last 4 digits of his SSN being 5555, Phillip's default password would be Ph01015555!

MyWarren

My Warren, accessible from the link at the top of our home page at www.warren.edu, is where all your classroom, scheduling and billing information is.

Your username is your student ID number.

If you are a **new** student or **don't remember your password** for MyWarren, complete the following steps:

1. Go to the WCCC homepage at www.warren.edu and click on MyWarren.
2. In the username box, put in your WCCC ID number.
3. Click where it says "I forgot my password" under the password box.
4. When you are prompted to add your email address, this is your personal email address that you used when you registered for class. Unless you have changed this email address with Student Services, it will not be your WCCC email address.
5. After you've put in your email address, click "Send."

This will send an email to the email account you indicated when you were resetting the password.
