PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSISTANT Associate in Applied Science (Joint Program with Union County College)

The Physical Therapist Assistant Program is an accredited course of study composed of specialized courses in physical therapy, planned clinical training and general education. The General Education courses will be taught by WCCC faculty on the WCCC campus, while the Physical Therapist Assistant courses will be taught by the Union County College (UCC) faculty and academic specialists, at UCC's Plainfield campus, in accordance with requirements established for the degree. Students successfully completing the degree program will be granted the Associate in Applied Science Degree by UCC and are eligible to take the state licensure examination.
