CRIMINAL JUSTICE Associate in Science

The Criminal Justice Program is designed for students seeking employment in the corrections and law enforcement fields. The program is suitable for students planning to transfer to a four-year institution to pursue a baccalaureate degree in criminal justice or other related fields. It is also suitable for individuals looking for immediate employment, or those already employed in the field and seeking advancement. Graduates are eligible to seek entry-level positions in parole, probation, security, corrections, and governmental agencies, including police departments.

Criminal Justice studies include adult and juvenile adjudication systems; the role of police, courts, and corrections; criminal law, and theories pertaining to criminal behavior.
