OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT Associate in Science Degree (Joint Program with Rutgers – School of Health Related Professions)

This joint program prepares Occupational Therapy Assistants (OTA) as professional practitioners who will contribute to the health and wellbeing of individuals by enabling participate in meaningful occupations and adaption to challenging life circumstances. Graduates of the OTA program will be eligible to sit for the national Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA) examination. Once licensed, COTAs can pursue entry-level positions in healthcare, education, and community settings, and work under the supervision of an occupational therapist (OT). In these settings the COTA works with individual who are challenged by disability, trauma, and/ or the aging process to develop, restore, or enhance their occupational performance and participation. Students complete a minimum of 16 credits at WCCC before applying to Rutgers for the professional phase of the OTA Program.
