EOF Counseling

The EOF Office is staffed by highly trained professionals committed to fostering student development and success. Through a comprehensive range of services, they provide personalized support to all EOF students. Each student is guided and assisted by an EOF Professional throughout their journey, from enrollment to graduation at Warren County Community College.

EOF Summer Scholars Program

The EOF Summer Scholars Program is a state-funded initiative designed for first-time, full-time college students entering the EOF Program. This intensive six-week pre-college preparatory program provides students with a valuable head start on their college journey.

The program is offered at no cost to participants and includes textbooks, lunch vouchers, and a weekly travel stipend to support their success.

EOF Workshops

The EOF program provides workshops on a variety of topics relevant to student life, including study skills, time management, test-taking strategies, effective communication, and more.

In addition to these practical skills, the EOF office places a strong emphasis on mental health and well-being. Many workshops are designed to address mental health topics, fostering a holistic approach to student development. This focus aims to empower students to become dynamic and well-rounded leaders.

These workshops are designed to enhance the overall college experience and support students in achieving their academic and personal goals. Attendance at these workshops is a mandatory component of the EOF program.

EOF Summer Grant
