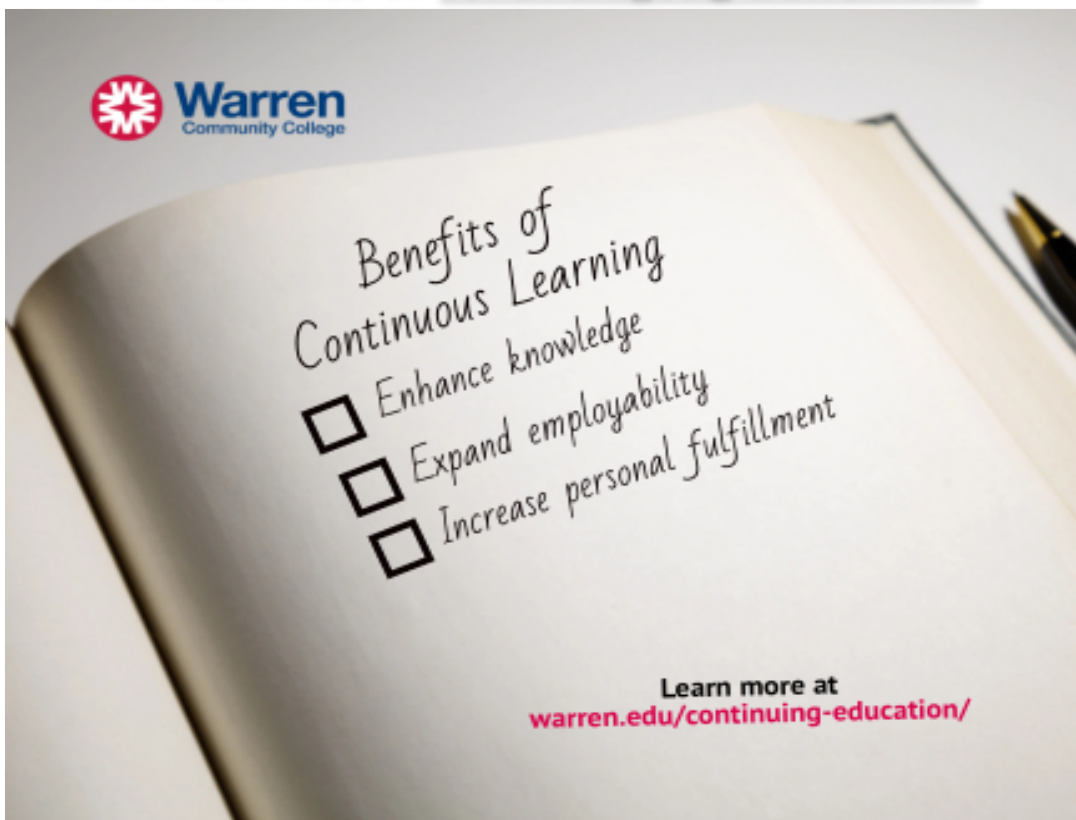

MEDICAL ASSISTING PROGRAM* (ENROLLING FOR FALL)

Medical Assisting

Highly Recognized, Nationally Accredited

The hybrid medical assisting program blends online learning with visiting the Phillipsburg Education Center and off-campus training sites for hands-on experiences. Meet each Tuesday & Wednesday from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm and select Mondays.



ATTEND PART-TIME OR FULL-TIME.

The hybrid Medical Assisting program combines online learning with visits to the Phillipsburg Education Center and off-campus training sites for hands-on experiences. Meet each Tuesday & Wednesday, and select Mondays, from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. This seven (7) month, 760-hour full-time, grant-eligible program is nationally accredited. It includes Anatomy/ Physiology/Pathology, Medical Terminology, Pharmacology, Medical Laboratory, Clinical Assisting, Insurance/Coding/Managed Care, Computerized Office Procedures, Healthcare Law & Ethics, Psychology/Therapeutic Communications, Medical Office Procedures, 160-hour Externship (without remuneration), CPR/First Aid, and job search preparation. After successful program completion, students sit for the AAMA's national certification examination and are eligible to become Certified Medical Assistants – CMA (AAMA).

Prerequisites: 18 years of age, clear criminal history, H.S. diploma or equivalent, or current graduating H.S. senior, with knowledge of Windows and Microsoft Word. You must have a computer (not a MacBook) and internet access. **Registration begins with scheduling an interview.**

CERTIFIED PHARMACY TECHNICIAN (NATIONAL CERTIFICATION W/ PTCB)

The need for Pharmacy Technicians continues to grow, with demand expected to increase substantially through 2024. Technicians work under the supervision of a registered pharmacist in hospitals, home infusion pharmacies, community pharmacies, and other healthcare settings. This high demand for pharmacy technicians results from many factors, including the constant availability of new drugs, the national shortage of registered pharmacists, the establishment of certified pharmacy technicians, and the aging population. This program will prepare students to enter the pharmacy field and to pursue national certification via exam with the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB). **Prerequisite:** Students should have or be pursuing a high school diploma or GED.

This course covers the following key areas and topics:

- Pharmacy calculations
- Medical terminology specific to the pharmacy
- Skills to read and interpret prescriptions
- Review of the top 200 drugs
- Skills to identify drugs by generic and brand names
- Dosage calculations, I.V. flow rates, drug compounding, and dose conversions
- Dispensing of prescriptions, inventory control, and billing and reimbursement

Fiber Optics Career Courses

Sanctioned by the Fiber Optic Association (FOA), the world's largest professional society of fiber optics.

Provided in partnership with BDI DataLynk.

Registration is encouraged **one week before the start date of each course.**

CERTIFIED FIBER OPTICS TECHNICIAN (CFOT)

This comprehensive 3-day introductory course in fiber optics is designed for those aspiring to become Certified Fiber Optic Technicians. The training integrates theoretical knowledge with 85% hands-on activities – students are able to use and practice with field equipment in class through hands-on skills labs. Participants will also be introduced to current industry standards for FTTD (Fiber-To-The-Desk), FTTH (Fiber-To-The-Home), and Distribution Cabling. The course covers fiber type identification, connector recognition, installation, termination, splicing, and proper testing of installed fiber cables in accordance with current standards. Our goal is to equip students to pass the Fiber Optics Association (FOA) Certified Fiber Optic Technician (CFOT) exam, which is administered and graded on the final day.

CFOT is a prerequisite for all other BDI DataLynk courses. To successfully pass this course, the student must pass both the written and hands-on exams (meaning 70% of the questions must be answered correctly). All exams are closed-book. Tuition includes all books/study materials, exam fees, and three-year membership to the FOA.

Prerequisites: Basic knowledge of computers; ability to speak and understand English.

CERTIFIED FIBER OPTICS SPECIALIST IN SPLICING (CFOS/S)

This Splicing Specialist Training provides in-depth information about splicing, including an overview of OTDR functions and trace interpretation. The course emphasizes hands-on learning, covering key points to achieve high-performance splicing. Students will train in both fusion and mechanical splicing of single or multimode fiber optic cables. During these sessions, the instructor will demonstrate the use of various types of inside or outside plant fiber optic cables, as well as fiber optic enclosures and splice trays.

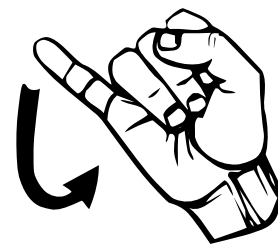
