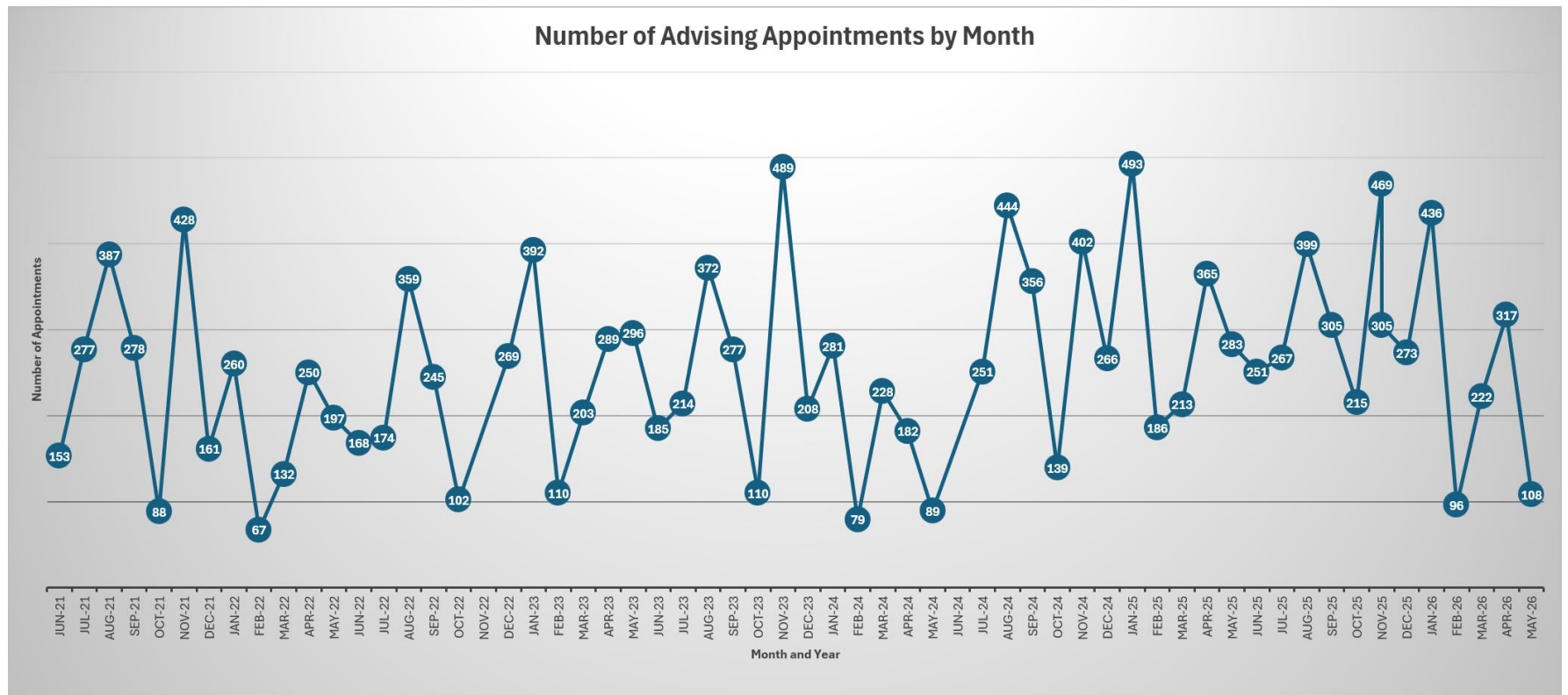

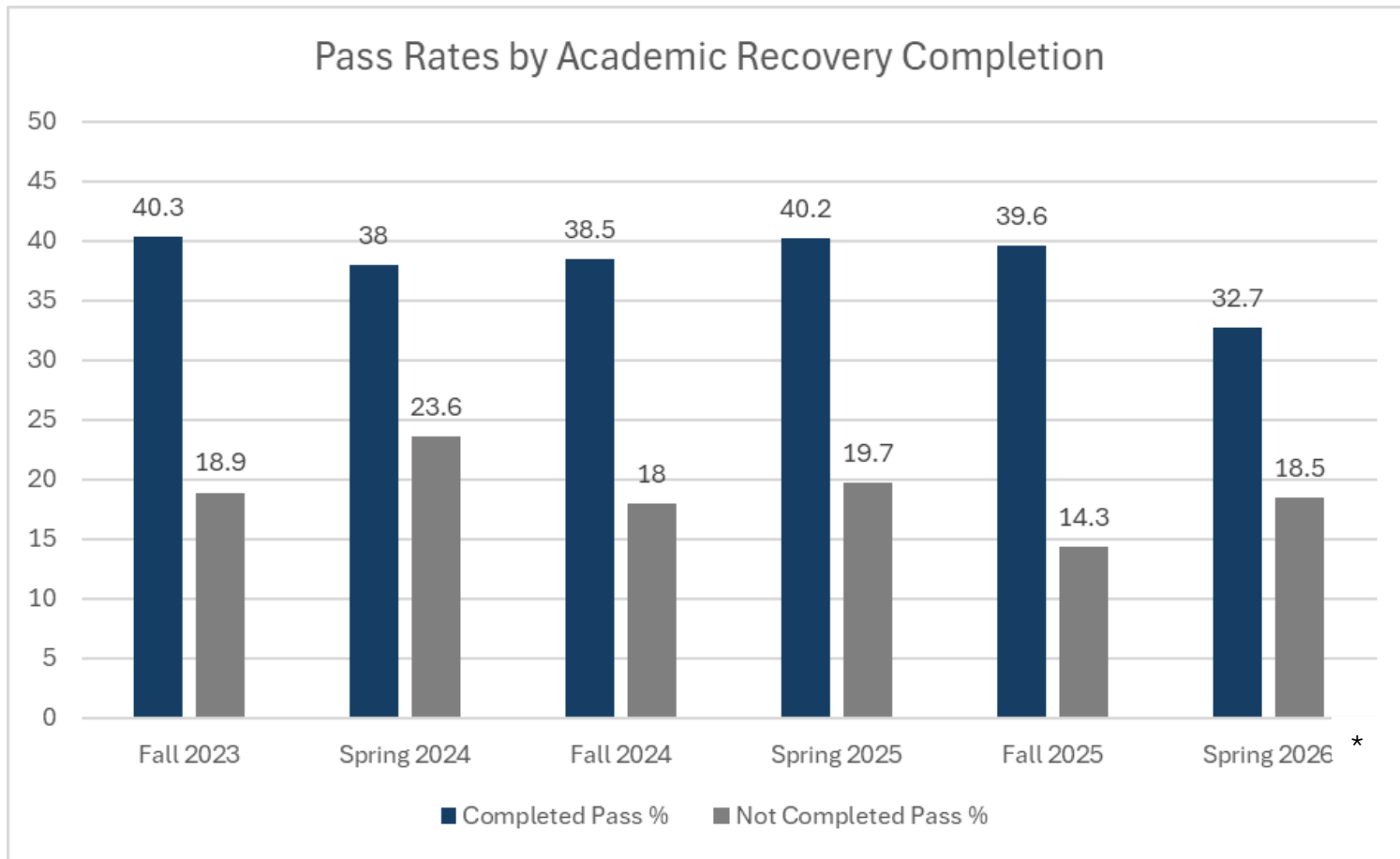

A chi-square analysis was conducted to examine the relationship between Academic Recovery completion and final academic outcomes across six semesters (Fall 2023 through Spring 2026). Results indicated a statistically significant association between program completion and student outcomes, $\chi^2(3, N = 1,717) = 81.51, p < .001$, Cramer's V = .22. Students who completed Academic Recovery achieved a pass rate of 38.5%, compared with 19.1% for students who did not complete the program. Conversely, completers experienced lower failure rates (31.2%) than non-completers (46.8%). Significant relationships were observed during every semester examined, suggesting a consistent and positive association between Academic Recovery completion and student success.

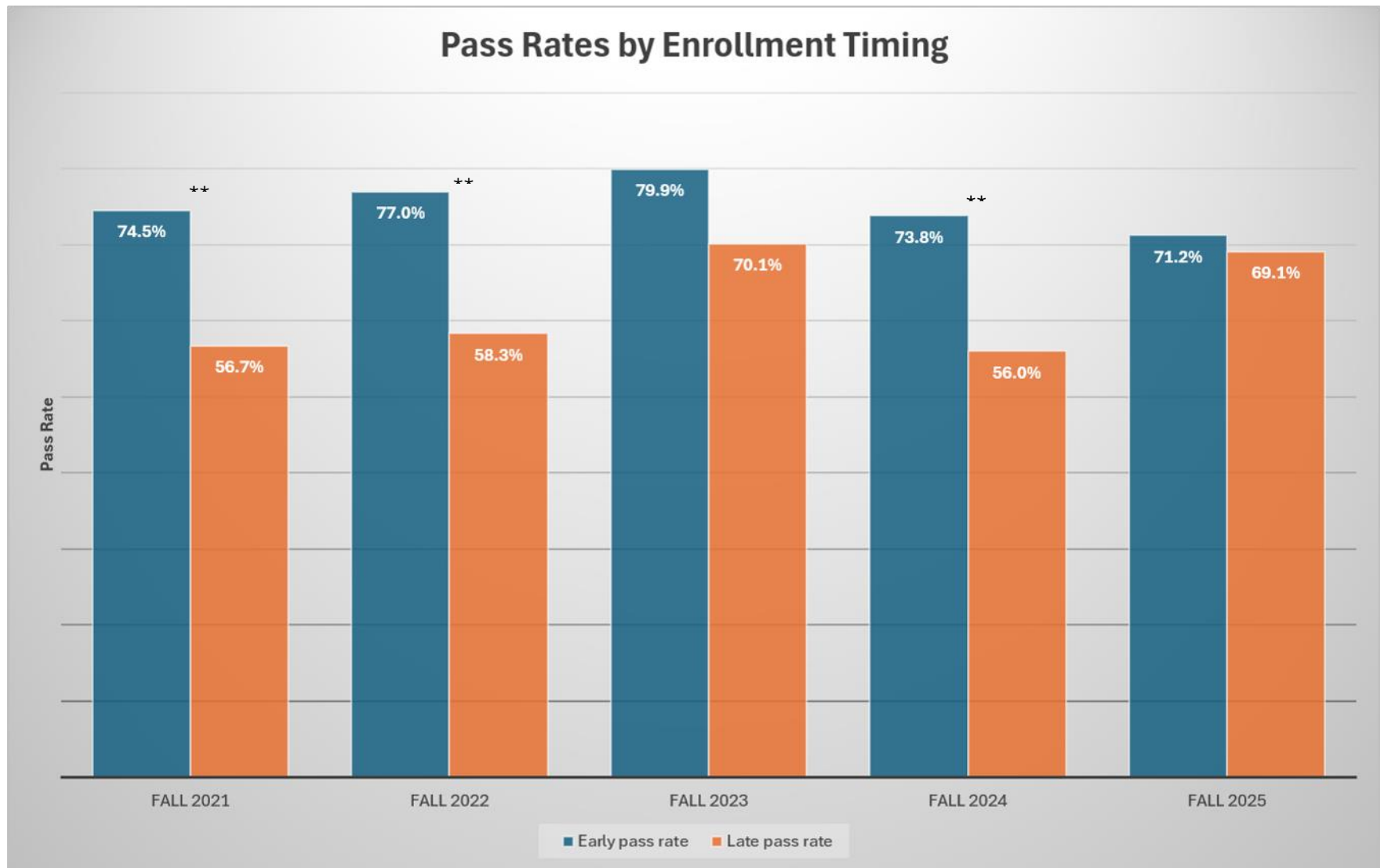

Students who enrolled before August 15 had higher first-semester pass rates than students who enrolled on or after August 15 in each cohort examined. The association between enrollment timing and semester success was statistically significant in Fall 2021, Fall 2022, and Fall 2024, but not in Fall 2023 or Fall 2025. The difference between the groups was smallest in Fall 2025.

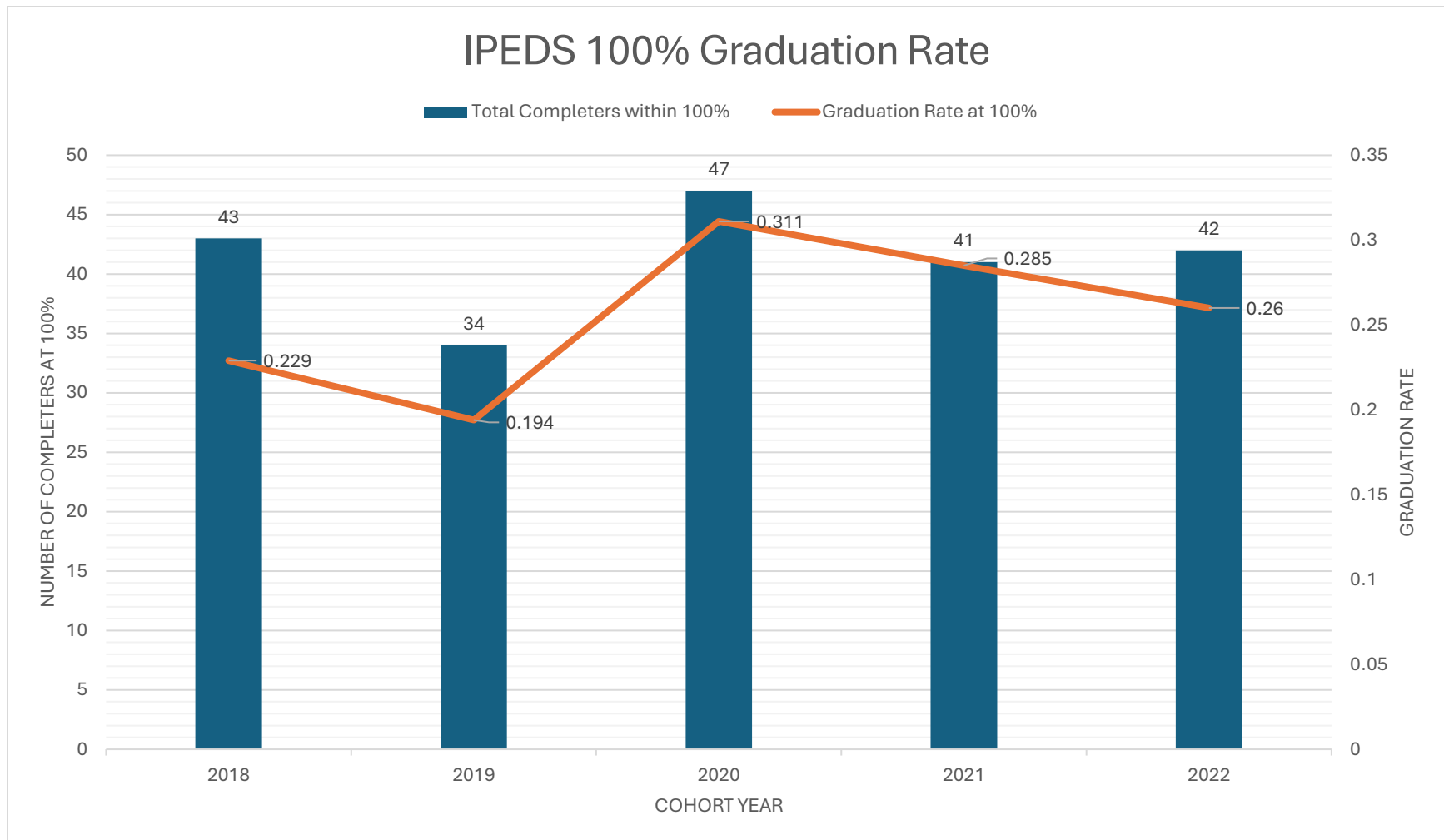

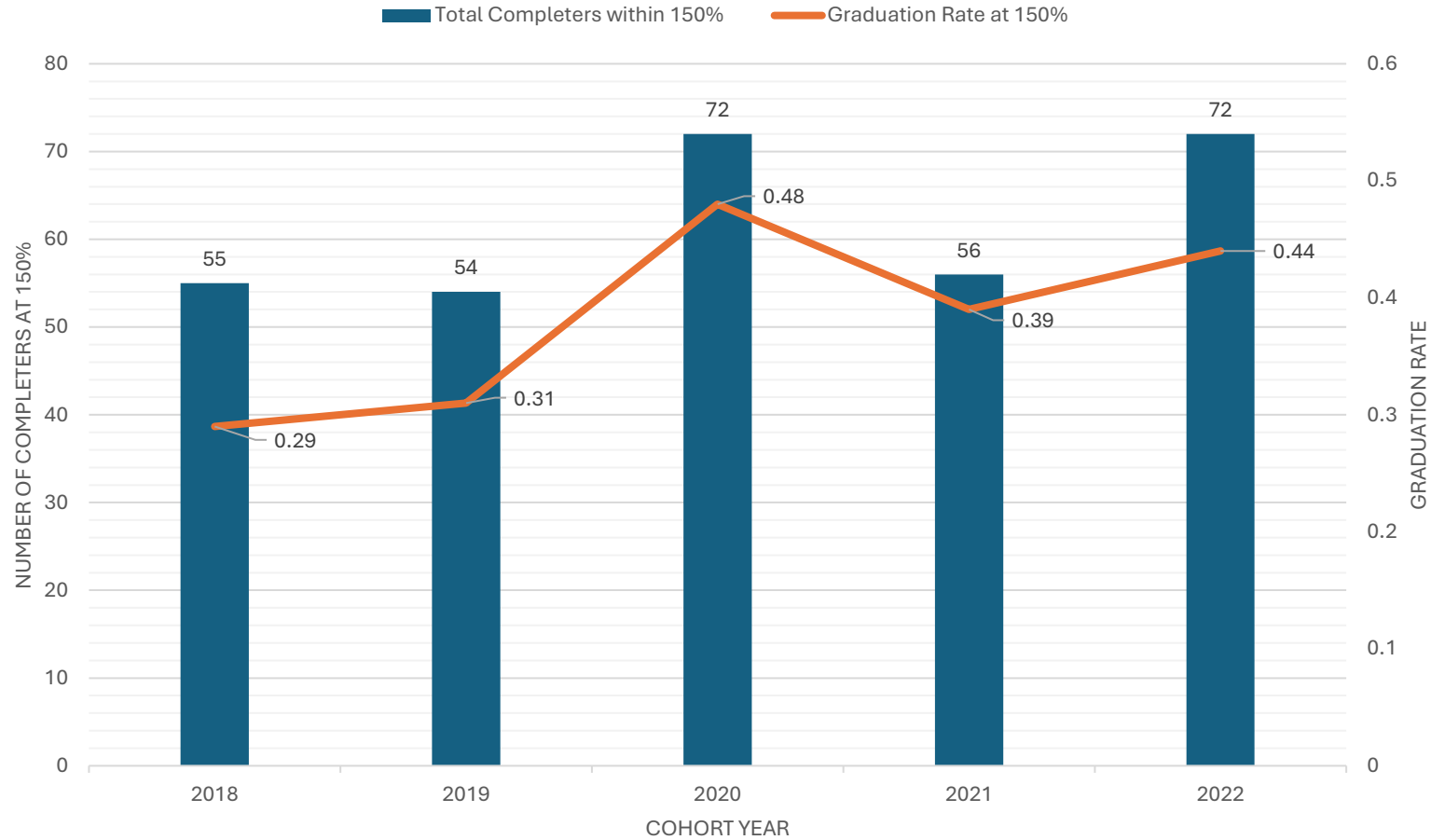
